Standard finishes for trigger sprayers are 24/410 (for the minis), 28/400 and 28/410 with additional options like a ratchet (non-removable) closure or an anti-rotational feature. Which nozzle to use is another consideration, with spray/stream/on/off being the most popular configuration; however there are many other options, see below for some of the most common choices. Output is yet another matter as this varies greatly from .2cc to 3.2cc and everything in-between.
